I hereby give notice that I wish to propose the creation of a "DINNER COMMITTEE".

I do not intend this proposal to be formally written into the society's constitution unless the meeting decides otherwise. In my opinion there have been far too many alterations to the constitution in the last nine years, most of which have been petty word changes, or have been reversed the the following year!

The government of the society is vested in those persons mentioned in Clause 4 and my proposal is aimed only at relieving some of the pressure in organising one major event in the society's calendar. In my opinion the" committee, if adopted, should include two

members of the society who are not on the committee (as defined in Clause 4), two members who are and in addition, a first year should be elected on to the Dinner Committee during the Autumn term. (This suggestion as to the make up of the Dinner Committee does not form part of my proposal and is included here merely to fuel debate).
